An amazing piece of Australian history and one of the most notable homes in the state Baroona's story begins as Rosemont in 1829 when the first stage was built by John Lanarch and Co. on land granted to James Mudie in 1823.

Albert Dangar acquired the property in 1869 and commissioned Benjamin Backhouse to design Baroona retaining the walls of Rosemount.

The tower and spiral staircase were designed by Frederick Menkins in 1893.
